- Most recent NAPLAN report
- Most recent OLNA report (if applicable)
- Diagnostic reports confirming Autism diagnosis confirmation from a paediatrician after triage with Speech Pathologist and Clinical Psychologist
- Signed Permission to Release and/or Exchange Information Form
