

Attendance Policy

It is a requirement under the Education Act that student attendance is monitored. Monitoring is not limited to obtaining explanations for unexplained absences. An attendance which falls below 90% of possible attendances is deemed to place the student at educational risk **whatever the reason for the absences.**

| Monitoring absence concerns | School Attendance Officer, SAER Student Services |
